Biodiversity Assessment: SNOWMOBILES in YELLOWSTONE

1. Scenario

You are the chief Park Planner for Yellowstone National Park in Wyoming. You need to recommend a solution to the big controversy surrounding the use of snowmobiles (motorized snow vehicles) in the park. After reading the background, come up with a solution that addresses all the points below. Be sure to follow all instructions. Ask questions of your instructor if you need to.

2. Background

Read background handout (class set) – can be viewed on website if you need to access outside of class.



3. Stakeholders

The "stakeholders" = who is affected by your solution. Be sure you address all 5 stakeholders.

- 1. Park rangers who use snowmobiles to do their work in the park.
- 2. The organisms (plants and animals) that live in the park.
- 3. Park visitors who are NOT snowmobilers.
- 4. Park visitors who like to use snowmobiles.
- 5. Local businesses who rent snowmobiles to park visitors.

4. Your Solution

- Explain your solution to the snowmobile problem in detail. What would you do?
- Make a strong argument that defends your solution.
- Explain WHY you chose to use these solutions and WHY you did not chose other possible solutions.

- Make sure your solution addresses concerns of all 5 stakeholders
